

# Mudajaya, Mulpha appoint former Bursa CEO as director

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Former Bursa Malaysia CEO Datuk Yusli Mohamed Yusoff has been appointed to the boards of Mudajaya Group Bhd and Mulpha International Bhd. In separate statements yesterday, both companies announced Yusoff's appointment as independent, non-executive director.

The 52-year-old Yusli, who was trained in accounting, headed the local stock exchange from February 2004 until March this year. He also holds directorships in the Asian Institute of Finance Bhd and has been the chairman of Red Cliff Group Pte Ltd since April this year.

Meanwhile, Mulpha also announced the appointment of Loong

Caesar, 51, as independent non-executive director. Also chief executive partner at Raslan Loong Advocates & Solicitors, Loong does not currently hold a board seat in any other public companies.

Separately, Mudajaya announced the appointment of David George Savage, 51, as an independent, non-executive director. Savage, an Australian with over 25 years experience in the construction industry in Asia, has held several senior executive roles.

He retired from the role of chief operating officer of Leighton Holdings Ltd in March 2011 to pursue private business and other interests, Mudajaya's statement read.
